Product Group:	Adhesive foam paddings. – sheets coated with low allergy adhesive
Intended use:	These devices are simple paddings materials intended to provide relief from the effects of friction and or pressure.
Composition:	These products consist of various thicknesses of polyurethane foams coated on one side with a medical grade adhesive. The adhesive surface is covered with a protective release material, which is removed immediately before use. The products are supplied in sheet form or in pre-cut shapes.
Health Hazards:	The use of adhesive directly on the skin in a minority of cases causes local sensitisation. Removal of the device will prevent further damage but symptoms may persist for varying amounts of time. The adhesive used with these products is known to be suitable for use on sensitive skin. The likelihood of anyone becoming sensitised is therefore extremely low.
Combustion Hazards:	These products will burn with the release of toxic fumes and acrid smoke. They are best extinguished using foam or dry powder extinguishers.
	Individuals who inhale the smoke or fumes should seek medical attention.
Storage Requirements:	These products should be stored in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
Disposal after use:	These products will gradually decompose if sent for landfill. They may also be disposed of by incineration if contamination classifies then as healthcare waste. They are not suitable for recycling due to difficulties in removing the adhesive layer and possible contamination from the patient.
